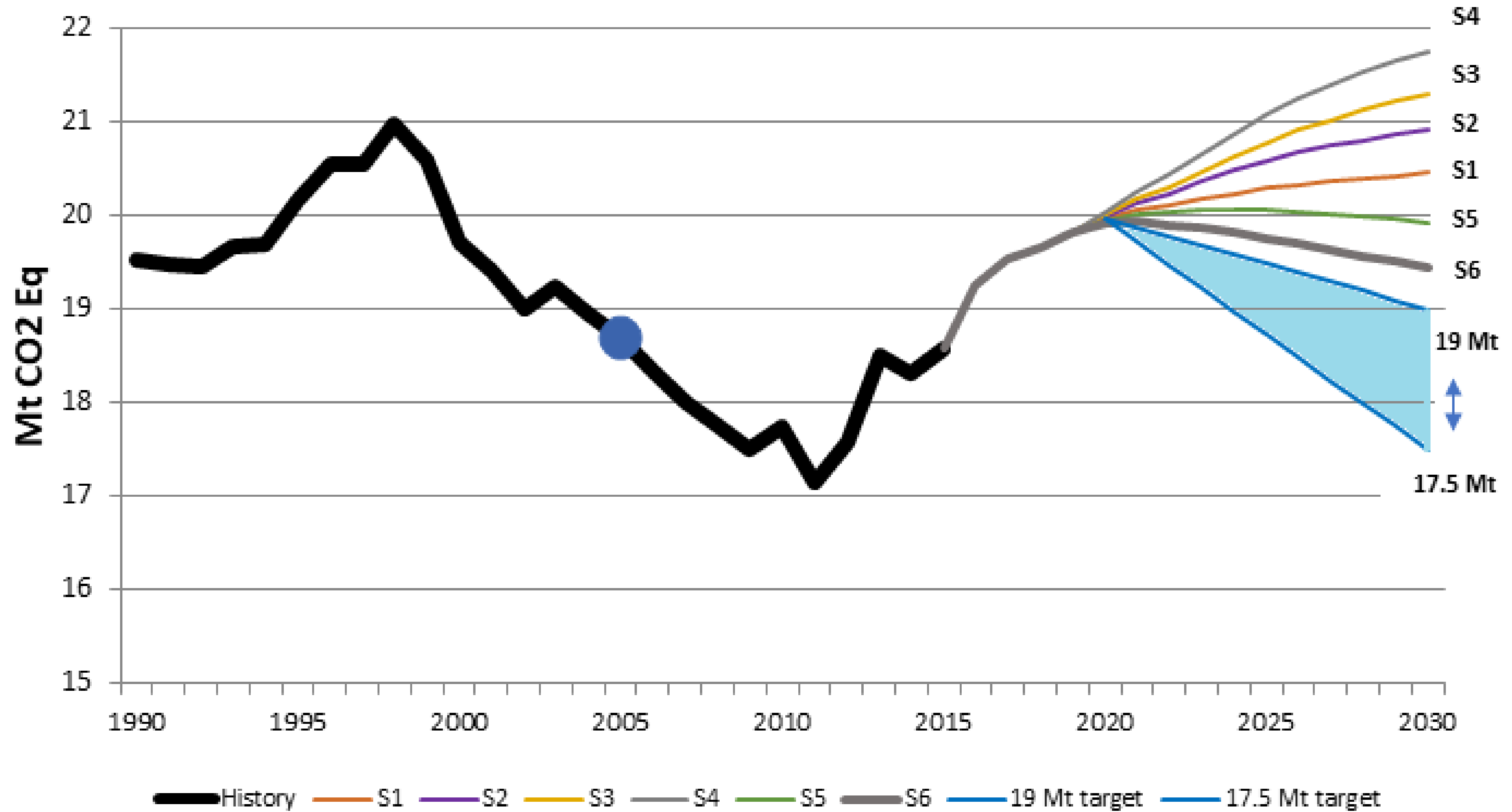


Key Sectoral Targets The Climate Action Plan
