The first three are all video-conferencing facilities. Eir Conferencing is purely tele-conferencing. We have trialled the above and found all to function with the technology and connectivity we have to hand. Each co-operative would need to trail them to figure out what works best for the set up and users that they currently have.

ZOOM (https://zoom.us/) can be downloaded from the Play Store for Android and App Store for iPhone. Installation and set up is simple, whilst setting up meetings is also straight forward. Picture quality is good within a good wifi range. Can be used on laptop or mobile. Host pays costs involved in the call.
